Aconcagua	Sandhill Preservation	Elongated, sweet, heirloom from Argentina, roast when mature or eat fresh, 75-85 days
Alma Paprika	Sandhill Preservation	Thick walled, cherry type pepper, 70-80 days, sweet, mild, good for drying and grinding
Antohi Romanian	Johnny's	Early yield, 50 days yellow, 78 red
Baby Belles	Renee's	Bite size, crisp texture, heavy producers
California Wonder Golden	Baker Creek	78 days, produces early, good for northern climates
Carmen	Johnny's	Italian, bullhorn type, 6"x2.5", ripens red, matures early 60 days green, 80 red
Chocolate Beauty	Baker Creek	Early bell-70 days, ripens green to brown, thick flesh, medium size, block shape, productive
Corbachi	Baker Creek	Long peppers straight or curvy, productive, Turkish heirloom, good for pickling or frying
Corno de Toro Rosso	Baker Creek	8" tapered, red, Italian, good yield
Doux de Espagna	Baker Creek	Long, cone shape, good for frying or salads, introduced before 1860, Reported disease resistant
Flamingo	Harris Seeds	Hybrid, 3 ½ " x 3 ½", prolific, TMV resistant
Friariello di Napoli	Baker Creek	Famous frying pepper of Naples, heirloom, small, long, cone shaped, productive
Giant Marconi	Harris Seeds	Matures earlier than other Marconis. 8" long x 3" wide, good for roasting or grilling
Italian Marconi Golden	Botanical Interests	Good for roasting, 6'-10" long x 3" wide, resistant to potato virus
Jewel Toned-Admiral Golden Bell	Renee's	High yield, disease resistant, plump, and vigorous
Jewel Toned-Northstar Crimson Bell	Renee's	High yield, disease resistant, plump, and vigorous
Jewel Toned-Gourmet Orange Bell	Renee's	High yield, disease resistant, plump, and vigorous
Jimmy Nardello	Peaceful Valley/Baker Ck.	So. Italy, long, thin skinned, ripens deep red, prolific
Lipstick	Baker Creek	70 days, 4" long tapered, early, ripens well in north
Mira	Baker Creek	Super early Polish variety, large, thick walled, crisp, very mild flavor
New Ace	Harris Seeds	Early variety, good yields, 3-4 lobes with thick walls, 65 days
Oda	Baker Creek	Compact, tapered bell, purple fruits ripen to red brown, thick walled, 70 days
Odessa Market	Baker Creek, Fed Co Seeds	Sweet pepper with thick walls, productive, 87 days
Orange Gilboa/Red Yardenne	Renee's	Vigorous bell peppers with early fruit
Paprika-Hungarian Magyar	Renee's	Slender, pointed 4" peppers, early ripening, dry and grind into paprika
Quadrato d'Asti Giallo	Baker Creek	80 days, huge yellow block shaped peppers with thick walls, high yields
Red Marconi	Baker Creek	80 days, late Italian pepper, 7" long tapering fruit, very sweet
Rotunda (a.k.a. Bulgarian Ratund)	Baker Creek	Round shape, sweet taste, good for pickling
Sheepnose Pimento	Baker Creek	Round, thick walled Ohio heirloom, ripens red, 70 days

Sunset Mix	Renee's	Italian heirloom, huge, elongated tapering fruits, ripens red, yellow or orange
Sweet Sequoia	Sequoia School Sta Rosa	Large red pimento type, thick fleshed, adapted to this area, fruits late. Delicious!
Mildly Spicy Peppers		
Italian Pepperoncini	Baker Creek	Sicilian. Crisp, thick-walled, sweet, and juicy with a hint of heat. Often pickled.
Shishito Pepper	Baker Creek	Mild, 2"-3", like Padrons but thinner & more wrinkly, 75 days, Japanese favorite for tempura
Spicy Peppers (SHU's refers to Scoville Heat Units)		
Anaheim	Cornucopia	Mild, Mexican and SW cooking, light green, chili relleno
Ancho San Luis	Renee's	Dark green, heart shaped, mild flavor, good for chili rellenos
Black Hungarian	Seed Savers/Peaceful	75 days, black fruit shaped like jalapeno, mildly hot. Ornamental purple flowers
Bulgarian Carrot	Sandhill Preservation	Fruity, hot flavor, ripens orange, 3 ½" long, 70-80 days
Cayenne Carlo Putini	Sandhill Preservation	Italian heirloom, thick walled, blocky, high yields, 80 days
Chinese 5 Color	Baker Creek	Multi-colored fruit-purple,cream,yellow, red, orange
Corne de Chevre	Baker Creek	Long thick pepper with medium heat, good yields
Early Jalapeno	Botanical Interests	Mildly hot, 63 days, Small @ 3", ripens red
Felicity Hybrid	Johnny's	Jalapeno flavor with less heat, 4 ½" - 5" long, good yields
Jalapeno	Renee's	Heirloom, abundant yield, harvest when deep glossy green or red
Jalapeno Sierra Fuego	Renee's	Hot and pungent flavor, heavy fruit sets need support, good for salsas and bean dishes
Joe E. Parker	Botanical Interests	75 days. 8" long, thick walled, mildy hot Anaheim. Good for stuffing or roasting
Orange Full Moon (True Thai Chilis)	Renee's	Ripens bright orange, medium hot/sweet pungency, good for sauces or salads
Padron	Renee's/Botanical Interests	Galicia region of Spain, harvest green @ 1"-1 1/2" for tapas, matures 3" red.
Pasilla Bajio	Sustainable Seeds	8-10", thin walled, slender, green-black peppers. mild, rich, smoky for mole sauces
Piccante Calabrese	Franchi	Round, 1'-2' diameter, moderate heat,Can be used fresh, dried, or pickled
Poblano	Cornucopia	Heart shaped, medium thick flesh, great for stuffing, 80 days
Red Savina Habanero	Renee's	Hottest habanero (380,000-500,000 SHU's) Yucatan characteristic fruitiness, plants over 3' tall
Red Vesuvius (True Thai Chilis)	Renee's	Hot and pungent, use fresh or air dry
Serrano	Cornucopia	Heirloom, good for sauces, moderate to very hot, ripens red
Tobago Seasoning	Baker Creek	Fruity taste, not too hot, very productive, ripens red or yellow, good for Caribbean recipes
Zavory Habanero	Baker Creek	Habanero flavor with mild heat, 2" long, ripen red, productive plants

Tomatillo Purple Coban	Baker Creek	70 days, heirloom from Guatamala, prolific, 1" diameter fruit
Tomatillo Pineapple (Pina)	Botanical Interests	75 days, mildly sweet flavor, husk turns tan when ripe, bottom fruits ripen first
Tomatillo Verde	Johnny's	Early maturing (60 days), large flat green fruits
Eggplants		
Asian Mix	Renee's	Blend of 3 early bearing varieties with clusters of purple, green, or white fruits. Mild and nutty tasting.
Beatrice	Johnny's	Similar to Rosa Bianca with earlier maturity, but fruit color is darker and fruits are smaller in diameter
Listada de Gandia	Botanical Interests	French heirloom, 80 days from transplant to maturity, 6"-8" oval fruit
Little Prince	Renee's	3"-4" oval fruits in clusters. Productive, compact plant
Long Purple	Botanical Interests	Japanese eggplant, 80 days from transplant to maturity, fruit 8"-10" long
Nadia	Johnny's	Traditional black Italian, dark purple, 7"-8" long, cooler conditions okay
Rosa Bianca	Renee's	Heirloom, rose and white, globe shaped, tender skin. Not bitter or seedy
